## **IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS**

**TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW:** This test is limited to 7 dogs. Entries will remain open until 5pm Thursday, September 3, 2015. If entries received exceed the test limit, a public drawing will be held at 7pm, Thursday, September 3, 2015 at Starbuck Coffee Shop, 10761 E. Alameda, Aurora, CO. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to POODLES first, followed by all other breeds.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$100.00. The entry fee includes the \$3.00 AKC event service fee and the 50cent AKC recording fee. Make checks payable to: Columbine State Poodle Club and send with entry form to: Karri R. Britton, P.O. Box 440847, Aurora, CO 80044-0847.

**ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note" on page 4 of this premium list), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE.** The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all the other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

## USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM

And write "VST" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephone, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

**THE ORDER OF RUNNING** will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Any exhibitor whose dog passes a VST Test AFTER the closing date for the CSPC Test but BEFORE the running of the test may withdraw their entry and receive a full refund of the entry fee PROVIDED that such withdrawal is made by phone, in writing or in person to the Test Secretary prior to the test and further provided that alternate exhibitors are available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

**RISK:** The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Columbine State Poodle Club assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. #### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
