**TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW:** This test is limited to 8 TD and 4 TDX dogs. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged on a basis of 2 TDs for 1 TDX. Entries will remain open until 5:00 pm, Thursday, Feb. 16, 2017. If entries received exceed the test limits, a public drawing will be held at 7:00pm, Thursday, Feb. 16, 2017 at **Caribou Coffee**, 1400 E Hampden Ave, Englewood, CO 80113.
