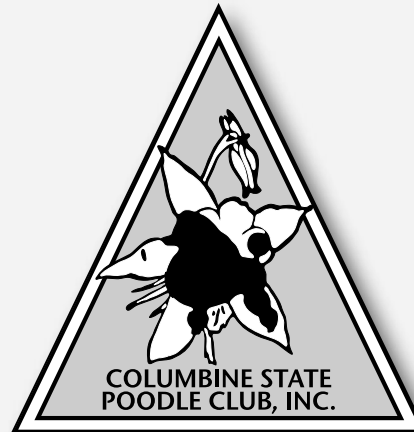

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

**VETERAN DOG CLASS      VETERAN BITCH CLASS**

Classes for Dogs and Bitches, seven (7) years of age or older. Must be in show clip.

First Place Winners of the Veteran Dog Class and Veteran Bitch Class are eligible to compete in the Best of Variety and Best of Breed Competition, if otherwise undefeated at this specialty show. Ribbon prizes will be awarded for first through fourth place.

**Note** - Chapter 11, Section 8, of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Independent Breed Specialties.

**BEST OF VARIETY OF BREED COMPETITION**

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes, Involving Multiple Dog Entries, is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry, judged first in these classes, will be eligible to compete for Best of Variety by virtue of having won one of these classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS** - The entry fee for Stud Dog Class (Stud Dog and get) shall be \$25.00 as a first entry, or as an additional entry of the Stud Dog. This class shall be for Stud Dogs and a minimum of two (2); maximum of four (4) of their Get. **Get MUST be entered in a Regular Class or Best of Variety Competition at this show.** Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Stud Dogs may be entered in Stud Dog Class only, or in addition to other Regular or Non-Regular Classes at this show. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The entry is only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. However, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or being excused under the AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the standard for the breed. Each unit of three (3) to five (5) (Stud dog and two (2) to four (4) Get) shall be an entity unto itself; no Stud Dog or Get may be shown as part of another unit. **Note** - Chapter 11, Section 8, of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, provides that neutered dogs may be entered as the Stud Dog. Stud Dog is required to be in sporting or show clip.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. **Note** - Chapter 11, Section 8, of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, provides that spayed bitches may be entered as the Brood Bitch.

**BRACE CLASS** - This class will require an entry fee of \$29.00 as a UNIT, or \$25.00 as a UNIT when BOTH dogs are entered in another class. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". Full particulars for each dog entered must be given on individual Official AKC Entry Forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". Brace Class shall be for two dogs of the same breed and variety of breed, with at least one common owner. Coat clips must be in accordance with breed standards.

The standard jump height groups will be judged in ascending order from the lowest to the highest. Excluding the Novice Classes, all entrants must include their dog's standard jump height in the space provided on the entry form.

**PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS**

(TO BE HELD PRIOR TO SPECIALTY REGULAR CLASS BREED JUDGING)

Entry Fee: \$10.00. Poodles that are AKC Champions of Record or holders of AKC recognized titles may be entered in the Parade of Titleholders. **Poodles entered in the Parade of Titleholders CANNOT be entered in any of the breed classes at this show.** Poodles so entered will be presented with a Rosette imprinted with the dog's name. Coat clips must be in accordance with the breed standards. Entrants should include with their entry, a resume of their dog's history (up to 50 words), to be read at the time of presentation.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

**JUDGE: MRS. JOAN LUNA LIEBES**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$10.00 for Junior Showmanship only, or as an additional entry of the same dog.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Each Poodle entered in a Junior Showmanship Class may be entered in one of the breed classes, or may be entered for Junior Showmanship only. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. A Poodle that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show, or the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSIFICATION**

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS** - This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - This class is the same as the Novice Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 and under 15 years old on the day of the show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - This class is the same as the Novice Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (Continued)**

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - This class is the same as the Open Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 and under 15 years old on the day of the show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS** - This class is the same as the Open Junior Class except it shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**MASTER CLASS** - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**BEST JUNIOR HANDLER** - The Junior Handlers placing first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for Best Junior Handler..

**NOTICE - Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.** A Junior Handler Number may be obtained by contacting the American Kennel Club. Phone: (919) 816-3776. Email: juniors@akc.org. **Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship is entered on both front and back of the Official AKC Entry Form.**

### PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

**ENTRY FEE:** \$15.00 for each Poodle entered in the Puppy Sweepstakes. Puppy Sweepstakes entry fee is in addition to Regular Breed Class entry fee.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Poodles that are at least six (6) months, and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show. **Puppy Sweepstakes entrants must also be entered in one of the Regular Breed Classes at this Specialty Show**, at the regular class entry fee. Entries must be on the standard Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, with "Sweepstakes" and the age division noted on the entry form in the "Additional Classes" space. **A Champion of Record or a Champion according to the owner's records, as of the closing date and time of this show, may not be entered in the Puppy Sweepstakes.**

## VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

**ENTRY FEE:** \$15.00 for each Poodle entered in the Veteran Sweepstakes, whether as a first entry, or as an additional entry.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Poodles entered in the Veteran Sweepstakes must be seven (7) years of age or older. Entrants may be spayed or neutered. **Entry in another class is NOT required.** Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged in accordance with regular breed judging regulations. Entries must be on the standard Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, with "Sweepstakes" and the age division noted on the entry form in the "Additional Classes" space.

**ACCEPTABLE CLIPS FOR VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES ENTRANTS:** Any clip, with the exception of designer or grooming contest clips. Face and feet shaved; ears may be tasseled, feathered or shaved; tail may have pompom or short blanket of hair. **NO FANCY ADORNMENTS** (e.g. collars, bows, bandannas, etc.). No clip that would have the Poodle resemble any other breed.

## OBEDIENCE TRIAL TROPHY PRIZES

A qualifying score is required for the awarding of ribbons and prizes in all Regular, Alternative Titling and Optional Titling Obedience Trial Classes. Scores from the Alternative Titling, Optional Titling and Non-Regular Obedience Trial Classes shall not count toward any high scoring prize. 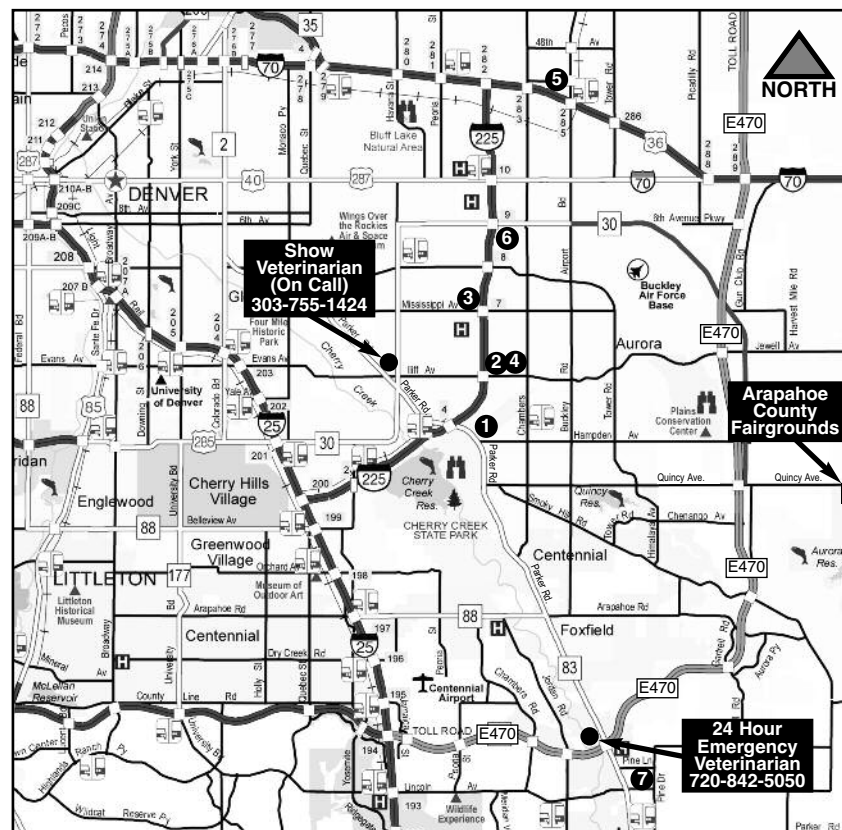

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
